General conditions



The stay in Denmark is generally paid by the Lions Clubs in Denmark, whereas the sponsoring Lions Club of the Youth Exchange Student is responsible for insurance and reasonable pocket money.

We will accept youths who have not taken part of the YCE Programme before.

To make the reservation in a specific camp in Denmark, the European Application Form, AF, must be filled in and sent by email as an Excel attachment not later than 15 March 2019.

Only the European electronic filled in Application Form will be accepted.

You will receive the acceptance with practical information about your exchange when we receive:

- a scanned version of the application form page 3 with all required signatures;
- a lifelike portrait photo (head to shoulders) of the applicant and a family photo;
- a letter to "Dear Unknown Host Family"; and
- a copy of valid passport or, for Schengen citizens, copy of valid ID-card.

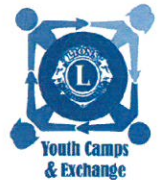
